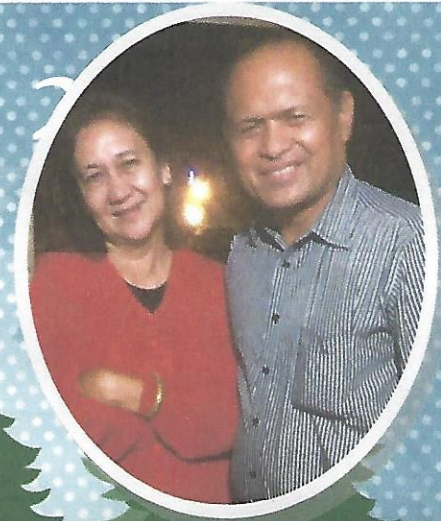


In Manado we have 7 who finished their Bachelor's degrees and one with a Master's degree in Theology. They wrote and defended their theses and earned their government accredited degrees. All of them are now taking an active ministry and some are now helping us by teaching in the Bible School.

Fandri is a young lawyer who responded to the call to the ministry and decided to enroll for his Master's degree 4 years ago. He is now one of our teachers.

Besides teaching the students we also organized special seminars geared towards specific topics. This year we had two seminars in our area where we took an active part. The first one was on "The Reliability of the Scriptures" which took place last April. The other one was on the "End Times" which took place on September. Then last month in Borneo Pastor Suyono who is the head of the Borneo Bible College and also the head of their denomination invited me to be their speaker for their

"Two Days Women's Seminar." The attendance was over five hundred women.

We would like to open more locations for classes in the neighboring towns and cities since we now have more helpers. Also we see the need of registering the mission officially in Indonesia to have legal coverage.
