## NOTABLE PERSONS OF THE BIBLE

### *“Elisabeth”*

A relative of Mary, the mother of the Lord Jesus, Elisabeth and her husband Zacharias, “*were both righteous before God.*” This childless couple were both old when the angel Gabriel appeared to Zacharias in the Temple as he carried out his duties as a priest. Gabriel’s message from God to Zacharias was that, in answer to prayer, his wife Elisabeth would conceive and bear him a son who would be “*filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother’s womb.*” Elisabeth became pregnant, just as the angel Gabriel said she would, and gave birth to a son that they named John as they had been instructed. He is popularly known as John the Baptist today. The ministry he was commissioned to was to “*go before the face of the Lord to prepare His ways*” (see Luke chapter one for the full account). John said that the purpose of his ministry of baptizing was that Jesus Christ “*should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water*” (John 1:31; see vs. 19-34).
