Common Sayings from the Bible

“Lusting in One’s Heart”

While it was in use before, this saying gained notoriety when presidential candidate Jimmy Carter admitted in an interview that while he had never committed the act of adultery, he had done so “in his heart.” This was in reference to the Lord’s teaching on adultery: *“You have heard it said by them of old time, ‘Thou shalt not commit adultery’: But I say unto you, that whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart”* (Matt. 5:27-28). The Lord used this illustration to show that sin originates in the heart (see Matt. 15:18-19) and that sinful deeds carried out are symptoms of the inherent sinfulness that dwells in man’s heart. It also teaches us that our thoughts are as important to God as our actions are. While it is sometimes used irreverently, this saying generally seems to be used in the way the Lord Jesus Christ meant it, in the long run; *“your sin will find you out”* (Num. 32:23).
