COMMON SAYINGS

“The Powers That Be”

This term comes from the Apostle Paul’s admonition to believers to: *“let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God”* (Rom. 13:1). This teaches us that in His providence God is ultimately in control of nations and rulers of nations, and that believers are to subject themselves to the rules and laws of their country. No distinction is made between good rulers and bad rulers in this regard, but the Scriptures do make allowance for disobeying “the powers that be” if a believer is directed to disobey God’s Word. When the apostles were on trial for preaching the Gospel after being ordered not to (Acts 5:25-28), they say, *“we ought to obey God rather than men”* (Acts 5:29). Every blood bought saint should say, “Amen” to that.
