COMMON SAYINGS

“Prepare to Meet Your Maker”

Those who use this phrase are usually speaking of physical death with the “Maker” being God. Sometimes it is stated as a question; “Are you prepared to meet your Maker?” As a statement it means “get ready to die.” As a question it means “Are you ready to die?” It is associated with two passages of Scripture. First is Amos 4:12 where, through the prophet Amos, the Lord warned the people of Israel to prepare to face their God in light of the destruction He was about to bring on the nation. The second passage is Hebrews 9:27, which reads, *“And as it is appointed unto man once to die, but after this the judgment.”* A variation of this saying with the same meaning is “Have you made peace with God.” The principle expressed is important for each individual to give serious consideration. Where would you end up if you were to die today? Only those who have trusted in Jesus Christ as their Savior *“have peace with God”* (Rom. 5:1) and will be allowed into Heaven to enter into the presence of God to enjoy the blessings of eternal life. All others will, in the end, appear before their Creator to be judged for their sins and will suffer everlasting punishment (see Rev. 20:11-15). Are you prepared to meet your Maker?
