- Matthew 21:22 And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.
- John 14:14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.
- <u>Mark 11:24</u> Whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.
- <u>I Cor 14:33</u> for God is not the author of confusion but of peace as in all the churches of the saints
- <u>2 Peter 3:8</u> But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
- <u>2 Tim: 2:15</u> Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- **2 Tim 3:16** All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.
- <u>Mark 11: 25-26</u> And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. <u>But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.</u>
- <u>Col 1: 13</u> He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have <u>redemption</u> through His blood, the <u>forgiveness of sins</u>.
- **Eph. 1:7** In Him we have <u>redemption</u> through His blood, the <u>forgiveness of sins</u>, according to the riches of His grace
- **Eph. 3:1** For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward.
- <u>Matt. 10:5-7</u> These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: "<u>Do not go into the way of the Gentiles</u>, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. <sup>6</sup> But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. <sup>7</sup> And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven lis at hand.
- <u>Matthew 15: 24</u> But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."
- **Romans 11:13** For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as <u>I am an apostle to the Gentiles</u>
- <u>Galations 1:15</u> But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called *me* through His grace, <sup>16</sup> to reveal His Son in me, that <u>I might preach Him among the Gentiles</u>.
- <u>Romans 16:25</u> Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret since the world began
- **Romans 11:25** For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this <u>mystery</u>, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
- **Eph. 3:1-5** For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles—if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which was given to me for you, how that by revelation He made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already, by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets:
- **Eph. 3:8-9** To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ;

- **Eph. 6:19** and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,
- <u>Col 1:26-27</u> the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
- <u>Col 4:3</u> meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ,
- **Rom 3: 20-22** Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law *is* the knowledge of sin. **But now** the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference;
- **Rom 6:22-23 But now** having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- **Romans 7: 5-7** For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were aroused by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death. **But now** we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not *in* the oldness of the letter.
- Rom 16: 25-26 Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret since the world began <sup>26</sup> but now made manifest, and by the prophetic Scriptures made known to all nations, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, for obedience to the faith
- **Eph 2:12-14** that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. **But now** in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,
- <u>Luke 9:6</u> So they departed and went through the towns, **preaching the gospel** and healing everywhere.
- <u>Luke 18:31-34</u> Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished. For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on: And they shall scourge him, and put him to death: and the third day he shall rise again. **And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.**
- **Ephesians 2:18** For through him we **both** have access by one Spirit unto the Father.
- **Ephesians 1:13** In whom you also trusted, after that you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also **after that you believed**, **you were sealed** with that Holy Spirit of promise.
- Romans 8: 38-39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
