## COMMON SAYINGS

### “*Pulling My Hair Out*”

After gaining permission from the King of Persia, Ezra led a band of exiles from Babylon to Jerusalem to join those who had returned earlier with Zerubbabel to rebuild the Temple. Although the Temple had been completed fifty-eight years earlier and the sacrificial system of the Mosaic Law reestablished, many of the people of Israel, including priests and Levites and other leaders had not separated themselves from the heathen who were living in the land. When Ezra arrived and found out that the Israelites were intermarrying with these pagan people, he tore his clothes in astonished distress of mind and pulled hair out of his head and beard (Ezra 9:1-3). Today, it is common for someone who is faced with a dilemma or difficult task to say, “I am pulling my hair out” as an expression of their frustration.
