## COMMON SAYINGS

### *“Beard the Lion in His Den”*

This saying, which is often reduced to simply “beard the lion,” speaks of someone taking on a dangerous task and accomplishing it in spite of it seemingly being almost, if not, impossible to do. Today, we generally think of “bearding the lion” as a preemptive offensive move taken to gain the upper hand in a given situation. It is adapted from II Samuel 17 (see verses 33-35). In the well-known account of David and Goliath, King Saul expressed his strong doubts about David’s ability to defeat the giant saying: *“You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him, for you are but a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.” But David said to Saul, “your servant used to keep his father’s sheep and when a lion or a bear came and took a lamb out of the flock, I went out after it and struck it, and delivered the lamb from its mouth; and when it arose against me, I caught it by its beard, and struck and killed it”*” (I Sam. 17:33-35). David was saying that his past exploits showed that he did have the ability to take on this giant warrior who “defied the armies of the Living God” and win (I Sam. 17:36). Even more important is that David recognized that it was the Lord who gave him the victory over the lion and the bear and he would go into battle trusting the Lord to give him the victory over this arrogant Philistine as well (I Sam 17:37).
