COMMON SAYINGS

“A Labor of Love”

We often hear the phrase, “that was a labor of love” in reference to somebody having put a lot of effort and care into some project or cause. Generally it means that what was done was out of concern and for the benefit of others rather than for self. We find it used in the book of Hebrews where it says, *“For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labor of love, which ye have shewed toward His name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister”* (Heb. 6:10). In this verse, the writer of Hebrews, by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, is assuring those he is writing to that God is fully aware of their ministry to other Kingdom saints that they were engaged in and that He would not forget about it. With this *“labor of love”* that they were carrying out in *“His Name”* through their ministry to others, they were laying up *“treasures in Heaven”* where they could not be lost, ruined, or stolen (see Matt. 6:19-21). When Christ establishes His Kingdom of Heaven on earth, they will be rewarded for their faithful service, just as Grace believers will be at the Judgment Seat of Christ (I Cor. 3:11-15).
