 - o Don't make an idol out of the day & lose sight of what is important The God of the Pilgrims

1. Man Owes God Thanks

- a. Even the unbeliever owes Him thanks *Matt 5:45* (for sun & rain) *Acts 17:25* (for life)
- b. O.T. calls for man to give the Lord thanks *Ps 106:1, 107:1, 118:1, 136:1-9 1 Chr 16:34*

2. God's will

- a. Does it matter? Do you know it? You should *Eph 1:9*, 5:17 it's not a mystery nor different for each
 - i. All to be saved & come to knowledge of the truth (1 Tim 2:4), give thx *I Thes 5:18*
- b. God has always wanted, expected, deserved thx not doing so has ramifications
 - i. But man chose not to be thankful & result was the decline of man Rom 1:21-23
- c. Is there any situation that thx to God is inappropriate or unnecessary?

3. Bound to Give Thanks

- a. Paul says he is bound to give thx. 2 Thess 2:13-14
 - i. Bound = obligation, owed, debt, due, limitation fixing a boundary
 - ii. Paul is saying he has a moral obligation to give thanks for the Thessalonians being saved from trib

4. Give thanks for:

- a. His Grace 1 Cor 1:4
- b. He redeemed us *Rom 5:8*, *Gal 3:13*, *Tit 2:14*
- c. He qualified us to receive inheritance Col 1:12
- d. He gave us the victory 1 Cor 15:57, 2 Cor 2:14, 9:15
- e. He is faithful 2 Tim 2:13, Gal 2:16
- f. His glory revealed in us **Rom 8:18** (our current standing is holiness but then will be our "state")
 - i. Considering *Isa 42:8* this is extraordinary.
 - ii. Rom 8:18 speaks of the resurrected & glorified body & subsequent complete Christlikeness
