BIBLE FACTS

“The Rose of Sharon”

In the Song of Solomon we read, *“I am the rose of Sharon”* (Song. 2:1). *“Sharon”* was not the name of a woman, but a fertile plain that ran along the coast of Israel (I Chron. 27:29). It ran approximately fifty miles from the vicinity of Joppa north to the area of Mt. Carmel (Isa. 33:9). Today the Rose of Sharon is commonly used as a name for the hibiscus syriacus, a flowering garden shrub.

“The Liberty Bell”

The Liberty Bell, a well-known artifact from the American Revolutionary War of Independence, is located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This large bell, weighing over 2,000 pounds, is thought by most to have been rung July 4, 1776 to celebrate the official signing and adoption of the Declaration of Independence. However, there are some who claim this celebration took place a few days later. Regardless, it didn't receive its famous crack that day as popularly assumed. It actually cracked fifty or more years later. Nevertheless, it is a famous American landmark and millions of tourists have seen it. It is inscribed with the words, *“Proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof”*, which is a quotation from the Bible found in Leviticus 25:10.
