## BIBLE FACTS

### *“Rending the Garment”*

The tearing of one’s clothes is used as a sign of sorrow, mourning, fear, repentance, or anger in the Bible. This custom is still practiced by some Jews today. Following are some examples from Scripture. Jacob tore his clothes in sorrow over his son Joseph when he thought he was dead (Gen. 37:33-34). Joshua and the elders of Israel tore their clothes in mourning and fear when Israel was defeated by the men of Ai (Josh. 7:5-6). The wicked king Ahab tore his clothes in repentance when confronted by the prophet Elijah (I Kin. 21:27-29). Good king Josiah tore his clothes in remorse and repentance when the Book of the Law was recovered and read to him (II Kin. 22:8-11ff.). The High Priest tore his clothes contrary to the Law (see Ex. 28:31-32; Lev. 10:6; 21:10) in an outburst of self-righteous anger towards the Lord Jesus Christ whom he wrongfully condemned as a blasphemer (Matt. 26:62-66). The Prophet Joel put the figurative meaning of “rending one’s garments” in perspective when he told the people of Israel that sorrow and repentance over sin is to be an inward attitude rather than merely an outward show, saying to them; “*rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God*” (see Joel 2:12-13).
