COMMON SAYINGS

“Far Be It From Me”

In its popular use, this phrase is usually said by someone in regards to something they are not very likely to do, or to have done. However, in a negative sense, it is at times said when just the opposite is true, in which case it is used as a denial of having done something that, in actuality, they are most likely to do, or did do. In its positive sense it is derived from the book Job where we read; “...*far be it from God, that He should do wickedness...*” (Job 34:10). In this passage, Elihu is defending the absolute righteousness of the Almighty Creator against even any hint that God ever has, is, or will treat anyone unjustly. In effect he is saying, “God does not, and cannot sin, as He always does, and only does that which is right.”
