Scripture Reading

“I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul. I cried unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living. Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very low: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I” (Ps. 142:4-6).

Do You Know What The Bible Says?

“Is It Worth It?”

“And I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them as dung, that I may win Christ” (Phil. 3:8). The Apostle Paul declared that to come to Jesus Christ as his Savior, it was necessary to first cast aside as worthless refuse his self-righteousness and religious works. Only through faith in Christ alone can anyone have a personal relationship with God.

Our sin separates from the Holy and Righteous God of all creation. Outside of Jesus Christ, there is no peace with God, only enmity. No matter how hard we might try, we cannot make ourselves acceptable to God. Our sin is simply too great a barrier to our entering into the presence of a Holy God.

However, those who receive Jesus Christ as their savior are reconciled to God because He has *“made peace through the blood of His cross”* (Col. 1:20). In Him alone can *“we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins”* (Col. 1:14).

What is worth hanging on to in this world? Religion? Pride and self-righteousness? Tradition? Fleshly indulgence? Material riches? What is your answer to the question that the Lord Jesus asked His disciples; *“For what is a man profited if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?”* (Matt. 16:26). Jesus Christ has done what we cannot do. Through His death He purchased eternal life for us. Have you received God’s free gift through faith in Christ?
