

If There Were No Resurrection Scriptures

2 Tim 3:16 *All Scripture is given by inspiration of God*

Col 2:9 *For in Him [in Christ] dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.*

Lu 1:35b *The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.*

Ro 5:10a *For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son*

Acts 4:33 *And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus.*

1 Co 15:3 – 4 *For I delivered to you that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures.*

1 Cor 15:12 – 13 *Now if Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? 13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen.*

Acts 1:22 *beginning from the baptism of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection.*

Acts 17:3a *explaining and demonstrating that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead.*

1 Co 15:14 *And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty.*

1 Cor 15:2 *by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.; 10a But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; & 17 And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!*

1 Cor 2:2 *For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.*

Ro 4:25 *who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.*

1 Co 15:15 *Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God, because we have testified of God that He raised up Christ, whom He did not raise up—if in fact the dead do not rise.*

Ro 1:4 *and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.*

Eph 1:20 *and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places.*

2 Co 7:7 *and not only by his coming, but also by the consolation with which he was comforted in you, when he told us of your earnest desire, your mourning, your zeal for me, so that I rejoiced even more.*

1 Co 15:17 *And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!*

Eph 2:11 – 12 *Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands— 12 that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.*

1 Co 15:18 *Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.*

1 Co 15:54 *So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality.*

Ge 18:25 *Far be it from You to do such a thing as this, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous should be as the wicked; far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?"*

1Th 4:14 *For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.*

1 Co 15:52 *in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.*

1 Co 15:19 *If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable.*

1 Co 1:18 *For the message of the cross is foolishness to those that are perishing.*

1 Co 4: 11 – 13 *To the present hour we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten, and homeless. 12 And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure; 13 being defamed, we entreat. We have been made as the filth of the world, the offscouring of all things until now.*

1 Co 15:32 *If, in the manner of men, I have fought with beasts at Ephesus (in defense of his faith), what advantage is it to me? If the dead do not rise, “Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die!”*

Eph 3:1-3 *For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles— 2 if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which was given to me for you, 3 how that by revelation He made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already).*

Acts 9:15a *Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles.*

Ro 11:13 *For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry.*

Col 1:27 *God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.*

Ro 6:3-5 *Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father; even so we also should walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection.*
