

God's Word on Livelihood Scriptures

Eph 6:5 – 8 *Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ; 6 not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, 7 with goodwill doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men, 8 knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether he is a slave or free.*

Col 3:17a *And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus*

Col 3:23 *And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men.*

1 Thes 4:9 – 12 *But concerning brotherly love you have no need that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another; 10 and indeed you do so toward all the brethren who are in all Macedonia. But we urge you, brethren, that you increase more and more; 11 that you also aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, 12 that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing.*

Eph 4:1 *I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called.*

1 Co 7:20 *Let each one remain in the same calling in which he was called.*

Phil 3:14 *I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.*

2 Tim 1:9a *who has saved us and called us with a holy calling.*

Phil 1:27a *Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ.*

Col 1:10 *that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;*

Eph 6:8 *knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether he is a slave or free.*

Col 3:23 – 24 *And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, 24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.*

1 Co 15:58 *Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.*
