

What to do After We Have Sinned Scriptures

Mat 15:16 – 20 *So Jesus said, “Are you also still without understanding? ¹⁷ Do you not yet understand that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and is eliminated? ¹⁸ But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man. ¹⁹ For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. ²⁰ These are the things which defile a man...”*

Mat 26:41 *“Watch and pray lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”*

Gal 5:17: *For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary to one another; so that you do not do the things that you wish.*

Gal 5:19 – 21a *Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like.*

Gal 5:22 *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness.*

Ro 7:15 & 19 *For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. ¹⁹ For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice.*

Ro 6:1, *Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? Certainly not! (or God forbid!) How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?*

Gal 5:13 *For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity to the flesh.*

Tit 2:11-12 *...the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts (sins of all kind), we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age.*

Ro 13:14 *“Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts.”*

Eph 4:29 *Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.*

Ro 6:14b *for you are not under law but under grace.*

2 Cor 3:17 *Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty*

Gal 5:1 *Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.*

Gal 5:13 *For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.*

I John 1:9 *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

Gal 2:9 *and when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that had been given to me, they gave me and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship, that we should go to the Gentiles and they to the circumcised.*

Mat 10:5 – 6 *These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: “Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. ⁶ But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.*

Col 2:10-13 *and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power. ¹¹ In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, ¹² buried with Him in baptism, in*

which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. 13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses

2 Cor 5:21 *For He made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.*

Eph 4:32 *God for Christ's sake has forgiven you*

Heb 10:10 & 14 *We have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all... & 14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.*

Heb 9:28 *So Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many.*

Eph 1:6 *"He has made us accepted in the beloved.*

2 Cor 7:9-11 *Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. 10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death. 11 For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter*

Col 3:23 *And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men.*

2 Co 10:6 *and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.*

2 Co 2:6 *This punishment which was inflicted by the majority is sufficient for such a man.*

Heb 4:12 *For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.*
