

Jonah – Prayer of the Pouting Prophet Scriptures

Phil 1:29 *For to you it has been granted on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake.*

Jon 2:2b *“Out of the belly of Sheol I cried, And You heard my voice.*

Jon 2:6b *You have brought up my life from the pit, O Lord, my God.*

Jon 2:1 *Then Jonah prayed to the Lord his God from the fish’s belly.*

Acts 16:25 *But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them.*

Lu 16:24 *“Then he cried and said, ‘Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.’*

Jon 2:3 – 6a *For You cast me into the deep, Into the heart of the seas, And the floods surrounded me; All Your billows and Your waves passed over me. ⁴ Then I said, ‘I have been cast out of Your sight; Yet I will look again toward Your holy temple.’ ⁵ The waters surrounded me, even to my soul; The deep closed around me; Weeds were wrapped around my head. ⁶ I went down to the moorings of the mountains; The earth with its bars closed behind me forever.*

Jon 1:12c *For I know that this great tempest is because of me.*

Jon 2:3a *For You cast me into the deep.*

Jon 1:15a *So they picked up Jonah and threw him into the sea...*

Gen 45:5 *But now, do not therefore be grieved or angry with yourselves because you sold me here; for God sent me before you to preserve life.*

He 12:11 *Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.*

He 12:10 *For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness.*

1 Co 10:13 *No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.*

Je 29:11 *For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.*
